

2017 PROPERTY TAX REDUCTION

Idaho's Annual Circuit Breaker Program

You may qualify for a **property tax credit** of up to \$1320 if:

1. You **owned and lived** in a home or mobile home in Idaho that was your primary residence before April 15, 2017 (You may qualify if you lived in a care facility or nursing home.)
2. Your **total household income, after deducting medical expenses**, was \$29,640 or less AND
3. You are one of the following as of January 1, 2017:
 - Age 65 or older
 - Widow(er)
 - Blind
 - Motherless or fatherless child under 18 years of age
 - Former prisoner of war/hostage
 - Recognized disabled by Social Security Administration, Railroad Retirement Board, or Federal Civil Service
 - Veteran with 10% or more service connected disability or receiving a pension from Veterans Affairs (VA) for a non-service connected disability
